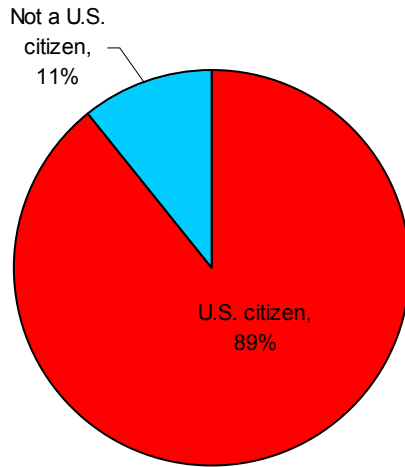


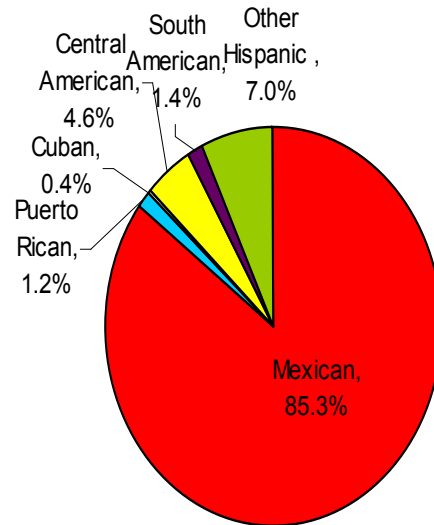
# Texas Landscape: Origin and Citizenship

**“Other”**

- Only 1,217,734 (5%) people in Texas identify themselves as an other racial/ethnic group other than Hispanic, non-Hispanic White, or Black.
- “The “Other” population is 76% Asian, 17% “Two or more races”, 6% “American Indian and Alaska Native alone” and the remaining 1% are “Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander alone”.
- About 38% of the Asian population are “not a citizen” (legal status unknown), they make-up 11% of Texas’s “not a citizen” population.
- About 68% of the American Indian population classify themselves as being of Hispanic origin. They are 1% of TX Hispanic population.
